Una nuova e originale traduzione del capolavoro di Joyce per il centenario della prima pubblicazione. Edizione interamente annotata e completa di schede di sintesi per agevolare la comprensione del testo. L'*Ulisse* di Joyce è una parodia moderna dell'*Odissea*. Episodi e personaggi riecheggiano le vicende omeriche, seppur attraverso ricercati espedienti narrativi come i tanti riferimenti letterari e non disseminati nel libro. I tre protagonisti si inseguono, avvicinandosi sulla scena, per le strade di Dublino nell'arco di una giornata, il 16 giugno 1904. Essi ricalcano i mitici personaggi omerici: Stephen Dedalus è Telemaco; Leopold Bloom, Ulisse; Molly Bloom, Penelope. Dedalus è in cerca di un padre, seppur putativo, e di un rifugio dalle sue oppressioni: patria, chiesa e impero britannico. Egli rappresenta il giovane artista, Joyce stesso, con tutte le sue teorie più ardite. Bloom non disdegna la compagnia del giovane Stephen ma quello che vuole soprattutto è riconquistare la moglie Molly che nel frattempo lo tradisce. Bloom rappresenta l'uomo comune, nei suoi ragionamenti o nelle sue esigenze, ma per la sua rappresentazione a tutto tondo, con le sue plurime capacità espressive, impersona l'uomo in senso lato, universale. Anche Molly incarna l'assoluto femminile, trae le sue radici dalla carnalità e dal potere seduttivo di antiche origini. Nel calore delle coltri, sul talamo di Ulisse, Penelope aprirà tutta se stessa in un interminabile monologo dal ritmo serrato privo di punteggiatura. Gli incredibili risvolti narrativi che caratterizzano il libro sono

sostenuti da continui cambi di ritmo e di stile, impervi giochi di rimandi e allusioni, con una scrittura fertile di influssi linguistici classici o contemporanei, nell'ottica di un'espressività letteraria innovatrice fatta pure di grande ironia e poetica virtù.
