In 1942, two years after returning to Canada from Britain, Robertson Davies took up the role of editor of the *Peterborough Examiner*. During his tenure as editor at the *Examiner*, a post he held until 1955, and later as publisher of the newspaper (1955-65), Davies published witty, curmudgeonly, mischievous, and fiercely individualistic editorials under the name of his alter ego, Samuel Marchbanks, "one of the choice and master spirits of his age." The *Table Talk* of Samuel Marchbanks gathers together a number of Marchbanks' columns from 1947 and 1948, presenting them as observations purportedly made by Marchbanks during a seven-course formal dinner.
