Die Vervielfachung der antisemitischen Straftaten, wie sie in Verfassungsschutzberichten zu sehen sind, verdeutlichen, dass dieser gruppenbezogene Menschenhass heute meist nicht offen ausgesprochen wird; mit Ausnahme des Internets oder bei Demonstrationen, wo die Anonymität oder der Schutz der Menge gesucht wird. Dieser Sammelband ist der dritte Band und Teil des Projektes "Antisemitismus. Nein Danke!". Dies ist ein Wertebündnisprojekt unter der Leitung des Gesellschaftswissenschaftlichen Instituts München für Zukunftsfragen.
