Chaque année, le Rapport sur le développement dans le monde de la Banque mondiale met en vedette un sujet d'importance capitale pour le développement mondial. Le Rapport sur le développement dans le monde 2018 -

APPRENDRE pour réaliser la promesse de l'éducation - est le premier consacré intégralement à l'éducation. Et le moment s'y prête particulièrement : l'éducation a toujours été essentielle au bien-être de l'être humain, mais elle l'est plus encore en cette période de rapides mutations économiques et sociales. Le meilleur moyen de préparer les enfants et les jeunes à l'avenir est de placer l'apprentissage au centre de toutes les interventions de promotion de l'éducation. Le Rapport sur le développement dans le monde 2018 aborde quatre thèmes majeurs : La promesse de l'éducation. L'éducation est un levier important pour éradiquer la pauvreté et promouvoir une prospérité partagée. Mais pour qu'elle puisse

réaliser ce potentiel, il faut améliorer les politiques - à l'intérieur comme en dehors du système éducatif. La nécessité de mettre l'apprentissage en lumière. En dépit des progrès accomplis en matière d'accès à l'éducation, les récentes évaluations des acquis scolaires révèlent que de nombreux jeunes à travers le monde, particulièrement ceux qui sont issus des couches pauvres ou marginalisées de la population, quittent l'école sans avoir acquis ne seraient-ce que les compétences nécessaires à la vie. En même temps, des évaluations scolaires comparables sur le plan international montrent que les compétences disponibles dans de nombreux pays à revenu intermédiaire sont nettement inférieures à ce que ces pays ambitionnent. Et trop souvent, ces lacunes sont cachées - par conséquent, pour faire face à la crise de l'apprentissage, il est crucial de commencer par la mettre en lumière en améliorant l'évaluation des acquis des élèves. Comment mettre l'école au service de l'ensemble des apprenants ? Les travaux de recherche sur le

cerveau, l'innovation pédagogique et la gestion des établissements scolaires, entre autres, ont identifié des interventions qui favorisent l'apprentissage en faisant en sorte que les apprenants soient mieux préparés, que les enseignants soient à la fois compétents et motivés, et que d'autres moyens soient mis en œuvre pour soutenir la relation entre l'enseignant et l'apprenant. Comment faire en sorte que le système favorise l'apprentissage ? Pour réaliser les objectifs d'apprentissage à travers le système éducatif dans son ensemble, il ne suffit pas de transposer à plus grande échelle les interventions efficaces. Les pays doivent aussi surmonter des obstacles techniques et politiques en ayant recours à des outils de mesure et indicateurs suffisamment parlants pour mobiliser les acteurs concernés, suivre les progrès, en formant des coalitions au service de l'apprentissage et en adoptant une approche de réforme évolutive.

panorama des méthodes et des outils utilisables pour les analyses phonétiques sur de grands corpus oraux. Les ressources considérables dont nous disposons aujourd'hui dans le domaine de l'oral, en sont venues à jouer un rôle majeur pour les phonologues et les phonéticiens, qui entreprennent de soumettre leurs hypothèses théoriques à des tests empiriques étendus. On a vu se généraliser l'utilisation d'un large ensemble d'instruments et de méthodes pour le traitement et l'analyse automatique des données recueillies. L'ouvrage aborde notamment le prétraitement des données acoustiques, l'extraction (semi-)automatique des paramètres d'analyse, la mise en relation entre les données acoustiques et les catégories phonologiques. Une large place est accordée à la contribution des technologies de la parole, et notamment les

This book is an interdisciplinary reader on the Faust theme in literature and music from the Reformation to the present. Essays by Faust scholars set the texts in context. Peter Werres introduces the collection with *The Changing Faces of Dr. Faustus*. Osman Durrani and Gerald Strauss discuss contexts of the Faust Book, given in the English translation *The Historie of the Damnable Life and Deserved Death of Doctor John Faustus*. David Wootton compares Marlowe's *Doctor Faustus* and the English Faust Book. Klaus L. Berghahn's analysis of transformations of the theme and seventeenth- and eighteenth-century performance announcements contextualize the popular Puppet-Play of Doctor Faust. Works of Faustian music include the ballad *The Just Judgment of God shew'd upon Dr. John Faustus*, Berlioz's *The Damnation of Faust*, and Gounod's *Faust*. Essays by Henry Bacon and

Steven R. Cerf engage the Faust theme in Romantic music and twentieth-century opera. Osman Durrani introduces 19th-Century American Fausts, represented by Hawthorne's *The Birthmark*, and excerpts from Ethan Brand and Melville's *Moby Dick*. Faust themes in the 20th and 21st centuries are represented by Valéry's *My Faust*, Shapiro's *The Progress of Faust*, Osman Durrani's overview of Faust globalized, and Paul M. Malone's work on the Faust theme in rock opera. A reading list is included.
