It was not so short, it retained the full width of the truck it was based on giving room for four passengers and their luggage, and not least of all it was a Chevrolet with the time-tested small-block V8 engine. It outsold all of its immediate competitors. In 1973 it was restyled and featured the most significant innovation for more than 30 years, full-time 4-wheel drive. A padded roll bar was introduced in 1974. About 83% of vehicles were built with automatic gearboxes. In 1979 it acquired a catalytic converter and a single exhaust pipe. This is a compilation of road and comparison tests, technical and specification data, owners' survey, and suspension modifications. Models include: - 350, 307, Safari, 400, Chalet, soft-top, Jimmys, 383, 400, Cheyenne.

He also challenges readers and demonstrates making stimulating music memories with good emotions that they would like to recall for the rest of their lives. He believes this book would be of interest to those exploring the science of depression, alcoholism, and addiction to nicotine and other drugs, as well as spiritual aspects of behavior. In the last chapter read about the author's most interesting and memorable pheasant and duck hunting and fishing trips. God has carried out his plan for Dr. Hazle. His sincere desire is that God would be glorified through this book.
