Based on the waistband options you select, you will also need iron-on interfacing, 1 inch (2.54cm) elastic, ribbon, shoestrings or cording, and thread to match. Full-sized pattern pieces are also included in this book; photocopy the pages or simply cut them out of the book, then tile as per the instructions to assemble the complete

pattern. Complete beginner-friendly instructions are included, along with a one page quick-glance cheat sheet guide for more advanced sewistas.
