Washington Irving's The Legend of Sleepy Hollow is one of the few early American short stories that is still widely read today. Most people are probably familiar with the story through the movie and television renditions of the story, the

earliest of which was in 1922, a version called *The Headless Horseman* starring Will Rogers as the main character, Ichabod Crane. In 1949, Disney created its own version, *The Adventures of Ichabod and Mr. Toad* with Bing Crosby narrating. This version, with its excellent use of visual symbolism, is fairly accurate, minus its lengthy chase scene. In 1999, Tim Burton's account of *Sleepy Hollow*, starring Johnny Depp, takes a different, darker approach with more head-chopping and less whimsical storytelling.
