Heute sind die meisten neulateinischen Epen Italiens im Internet leicht zugänglich. Gleichwohl erfordern diese Texte oft schon wegen ihres Umfangs auch für eine nur oberflächliche Würdigung viel Zeit und Mühe. Um dem abzuhelpfen, bietet das vorgelegte Werk griffige Zusammenfassungen und grundlegende Erläuterungen der ausgebreiteten Ereignisse unter Berücksichtigung

der dichterischen Qualitäten. Nicht wenige Epiker sind allerdings schon gut erforscht und allgemein bekannt. Es schien daher sinnvoll, hier nur eine Auswahl von 27 Epen vorzulegen, aus den fünf Jahrhunderten seit 1480, die bisher wenig oder gar keine Aufmerksamkeit gefunden haben - zu Unrecht, da es sich dabei um ausgesprochen originelle und literarisch hochstehende Gedichte handelt. Eine Fortsetzung der Reihe mit 40 weiteren Epen ist in Arbeit.

***** Today most Neo-Latin Italian epics are easily accessible via the Internet. Nonetheless, even a superficial evaluation of these texts often requires much time and effort on account of their length. To assist the reader, this work offers handy summaries and basic explanations of the events depicted, also taking account of the epics' poetic qualities. More than a few epic writers have already been studied in depth and are widely known. Therefore it

seemed sensible to present here only a selection of 27 epics from the five centuries since 1480 which have previously received little or no attention – unjustly since they are decidedly original poems of a high literary quality. A further volume covering 40 more epics is in preparation.

In a sequence of 26 homilies, Origen commented on the Book of Joshua (as preserved in Rufin's Latin translation). He interpreted Joshua's wars in the conquest of Canaan as an inner

struggle of the soul to overcome desire and vices on the path of ascent to God. Origen based this internalization and spiritualization of violence on the similarity of the names Joshua and Jesus in Hebrew, Greek, and Latin.

by the Roman Empire. In this book, Aaron A. Burke explores the evolution of Amorite identity in the Near East from ca. 2500-1500 BC. He sets the emergence of a collective identity for the Amorites, one of the most famous groups in Ancient Near Eastern history, against the backdrop of both Akkadian imperial intervention and declining

environmental conditions during this period. Tracing the migration of Amorite refugees from agropastoral communities into nearby regions, he shows how mercenarism in both Mesopotamia and Egypt played a central role in the acquisition of economic and political power between 2100 and 1900 BC. Burke also examines how the establishment of Amorite kingdoms throughout the Near East relied on traditional means of legitimation, and how trade, warfare, and the

exchange of personnel contributed to the establishment of an Amorite koiné. Offering a fresh approach to identity at different levels of social hierarchy over time and space, this volume contributes to broader questions related to identity for other ancient societies.

The term "biography" seems insufficiently capacious to describe the singular achievement of Joseph Frank's five-volume study of the life of the great Russian novelist Fyodor Dostoevsky. One critic, writing upon the publication of the final volume, casually tagged the series as the ultimate work on Dostoevsky "in any language, and quite possibly forever." Frank himself had not originally intended to undertake such a massive work. The endeavor began in the

early 1960s as an exploration of Dostoevsky's fiction, but it later became apparent to Frank that a deeper appreciation of the fiction would require a more ambitious engagement with the writer's life, directly caught up as Dostoevsky was with the cultural and political movements of mid- and late-nineteenth-century Russia. Already in his forties, Frank undertook to learn Russian and embarked on what would become a five-volume work comprising more

than 2,500 pages. The result is an intellectual history of nineteenth-century Russia, with Dostoevsky's mind as a refracting prism. The volumes have won numerous prizes, among them the National Book Critics Circle Award for Biography, the Christian Gauss Award of Phi Beta Kappa, the Los Angeles Times Book Prize, and the James Russell Lowell Prize of the Modern Language Association. In der vom Polytheismus geprägten Gesellschaft des Römischen Reiches galten Juden und Christen als Außenseiter, da ihre monotheistische Religion

sich nicht mit der heidnischen Götterverehrung vereinbaren ließ. Dies führte zu Vorurteilen und zu Repressionen. Eine zentrale Rolle für die Behandlung der Juden spielte deren Auszug aus Ägypten und die damit verbundenen Beschuldigungen gegen sie als ein Volk, das Seuchen verbreitete. Wurden die Christen zunächst als eine jüdische Sekte angesehen, so galten sie durch ihre starke Verbreitung zunehmend als Gefahr für

das Wohl des römischen Staates, was zu ihrer Verfolgung führte. Erst als römische Kaiser sich dem Christentum zuwandten, änderte sich dies. Nicht ohne Konflikt war auch die Begegnung zwischen Juden und Christen, da die Juden die Christen als Abtrünnige betrachteten und die Christen ihnen die Kreuzigung Jesu vorwarfen. Hass auf die Juden, der im "Dritten Reich" zur Katastrophe führte, lässt sich also bereits in der Antike finden.
