Open up the kicker cover and find my throwout bearing and the washers sitting in a bunch of pieces.Shovelhead clutch adjustment issuesjust so we're on the same page, by a "dry clutch", do you mean the standard shovelhead primary and clutch, or have you installed a belt drive? your adjustment procedure only works if you already have 13/16" clearance between the clutch release lever and round tower on top of the transmission cover. perform the complete clutch adjustment as follows:Harley..clutch..a release when i first start the bike and it...Hi guys. I've making the change to a diaphragm clutch release instead of the spring on my 1975 shovelhead. I don't have the manual for the diaphragm setup and need to know where to set the tension. I found that it should be .010 of flat and that's what I installed it to, but I'm having a couple...Shovelhead clutch conversion to diaphragm | Harley ...If you adjust the screw 1 turn, the clutch will engage closer to the handgrip as you release the lever. In effect when turning the clutch adjustment screw; you are adjusting the push tube and setting where the ball and ramps start to disengage the clutch. The release bearing is also known as the throw out bearing (on right side of bike).HARLEY

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
