in neglected and underutilized crop biotechnology, documenting research events during the last three decades, current status, and future outlook. This book has 16 chapters divided into 4 sections. Section 1 has three chapters dealing with *Chenopodium* as a potential food source, thin cell layer technology in micropropagation of *Jatropha*, and *Panax vietnamensis*. Section 2 deals with

molecular biology and physiology of *Haberlea rhodopensis*, cell trait prediction in vitro and in vivo of legumes, and application of TILLING in orphan crops. Section 3 has five chapters on biotechnology of neglected oil crops, Quinoa, *Erucia sativa*, *Stylosanthes*, and *Miscanthus*. And Section 4 contains five chapters mainly on genetic transformation of Safflower, *Jatropha*, Bael,

and Taro. This section also includes a chapter on genetic engineering of Mangroves.
