AFFIRMATIVE PATTERN – subject + first form of main verb + other words  
Singular Verb is used with the subject ‘He and She’ + All Singular Subjects. Plural Verb is used with the subject ‘I, We, You and They’ + All Plural Subjects. Examples:  
He/She talks.
