Do schools work differently in deprived and privileged neighbourhoods? As segregation is on the rise in many cities, this book explores how different neighbourhood contexts shape public organisations, by using an innovative approach that combines a Bourdieusian perspective and new institutional theory. Based on interviews and ethnographic data from two primary schools in Berlin, Germany, it shows how local social compositions, symbolic meanings of urban areas, and neighbourhood-based policy interventions structure schools. Italy's Alta Via 1, a 180km trail through the Italian Alps following the northern flank of the Aosta Valley, boasts magnificent views of the Alpine giants: Mont Blanc, the Matterhorn, the Grand Combin and Monte Rosa. Indeed, it is sometimes known as the Giants' Trail and can be combined with a sister-route, the Alta Via 2 (covered in a separate Cicerone guide), which runs along the southern flank of the valley, to form the Tor des Géants. Stretching from Donnas to Courmayeur, the Alta Via 1 offers fantastic alpine walking, with welcoming refuges and small hotels providing overnight accommodation (and great food) along the way. The guide presents the route in two sections, for the advantage of those who can't spare the full fortnight-plus needed to walk the entire AV1. The trail is described in 16 stages, with alternative stages covering some popular variants, including an optional detour to visit the famed monastery at the Great St Bernard Pass. Each stage includes clear

route description and mapping, plus notes on local points of interest and accommodation options. An alternative itinerary, list of useful contacts, kitlist and glossary can be found in the appendices. The AV1 crosses cols of nearly 3000m as it traverses the side-valleys of the main Aosta Valley. Suited to those with some of experience of alpine trekking, the walking is demanding but without technical difficulty. And the rewards are many: quieter huts, breathtaking vistas and a chance to immerse yourself in fabulous mountain landscapes overlooked by soaring, snow-clad giants.

The Bolivian scholar and activist Silvia Rivera Cusicanqui is a pre-eminent Latin American intellectual, world renowned for her work in postcolonial and subaltern studies. She has long maintained that we must acknowledge how colonial structures of domination continue to affect indigenous identities and cultures. Even in contexts where diversity and the value of indigenous cultures have been officially recognized, “internal colonialism” operates as a structure that shapes mental categories and social practices. This book considers this persistent colonial structure by examining artistic and popular practices of apprehending and resisting it, arguing that in Andean cultures there is a sustained practice of insubordinate image production and use. Combining this visual history with other instances of political resistance, the book offers an alternative narrative to the history of Latin American decolonisation. This narrative challenges the common conception that mestizaje (race-mixing) and hybridity are liberatory formations, offering instead a new theorisation of the complex racial configurations produced by colonialism and its afterlives. Given Rivera Cusicanqui's vital contribution to critical epistemologies, this book will be of great interest to students and scholars throughout the humanities and social sciences and to everyone concerned with the key questions of critical theory today.

Northern Italy's famous Alta Via long-distance walking routes are spread across the Dolomites, running roughly north to south and reaching as far as the Austrian border. There are six of these routes, and they increase in difficulty: Alta Via 1 has few exposed sections and is suitable for novice alpine trekkers; AV2 is much more challenging, only suitable for experienced alpine trekkers with a good head for heights, while AVs 3-6 have extended via ferrata sections and considerable exposure. AVs 1 and 2 are described in detail in this guidebook. The 120km AV1 is described over 11 day stages; AV.

The most northerly of Britain's island groups, Shetland is so far removed from the rest of the UK that it usually appears as an inset on maps. The islands also enjoy a dense population of otters, many seals, and a chance to see killer whales or other giants of the deep. Beyond all this natural grandeur, Shetland's history is fascinating too. The archaeological attractions are much less known than those on Orkney, but sites such as Jarlshof have amazingly preserved remains from prehistory right up to more recent times. These include iron age villages, chambered cairns, viking longhouses, pictish carvings, and impressive brochs – including the most complete of all these iron-age defensive towers, on Mousa. Besonders eindrucksvoll führt hierbei der neue Dolomiten-Radweg auf der alten Bahntrasse der Dolomitenbahn durch die imposante Bergwelt der Dolomiten. Auch der Radfernweg München-Venedig folgt weitgehend dieser, von Kay Wewior bereits 2010 vorgestellten Radfernwegverbindung. Dieses Buch enthält genaue Wegbeschreibungen, exakte Höhenprofile, übersichtliche Kartenskizzen, Infos zu Sehenswürdigkeiten sowie über 250 Unterkünfte (200 Hotels/Pensionen, 45 Zeltplätze, 15

Jugendherbergen). Nützlich sind die Angaben zu Infostellen, Radläden, Versorgung und Transport. Wissenswertes zum Reiseland, praktische Tipps und 63 Fotos runden das Buch ab. Für alle Touren sind die GPS-Daten kostenfrei erhältlich. Zur Strecke: Bis Wiesing (Tour 1-2) verläuft die Radroute auf dem Isarradweg bzw. der Via Bavarica Tyrolensis. Dann wird bis Innsbruck der Inntal-Radweg genutzt (Tour 3). Hinter dem Brennerpass (Tour 4) gelangt man in Südtirol auf den Eisacktal-Radweg, dem bis Franzensfeste gefolgt wird (Tour 5). Auf dem Pustertal-Radweg geht es weiter bis Toblach (Tour 6). Hier beginnt der Abschnitt des Dolomiten-Radweges, dem bis Belluno gefolgt wird (Tour 7-9). Der Radfernweg I4 führt schließlich durch die venezianische Ebene bis nach Venedig (Tour 10-12). Dieser Alpencross verläuft somit auf einer Gesamtstrecke von über 500 km fast durchgängig auf ausgeschilderten, oft sogar völlig verkehrsfreien Radwegen und Radrouten. Die vorgestellten Nebenrouten führen von Belluno über Feltre nach Bassano und weiter auf dem Radfernweg I2 nach Treviso und damit zur Hauptroute (Tour 13-15). Oder man nimmt von Bassano den direkten Weg nach Venedig (Tour 16). Einen Abstecher von Venedig nach Chioggia über die vorgelagerten Inseln beschreibt Tour 17.

Woven coverlets have appeared in several guises within the history of folk textiles. Created on four-harness looms, coverlets made in the nineteenth-century American South typically featured colored wool and cotton threads woven into striking geometric patterns. Although they are not as well known as other textiles and domestic objects, "overshot" coverlets were, and continue to be, significant examples of material culture that require tremendous skill and creativity to produce. They also express currents of conformity and dissent. In addition to being pleasing to the eye and hand, "overshot" coverlets have advanced a variety of social and political ends. At times exhibited in slave quarters along the seaboard in Georgia and South Carolina in association with plantation properties, they also appear in piedmont areas attached to the antebellum yeomanry, in the context of nationalist craft revivals, and in white-box contemporary art. With Overshot, Susan Falls and Jessica R. Smith analyze what we can learn by examining the exhibition and interpretation of these materials within American public history. By showing how geometric overshot coverlets can be understood in relationship to the global economy and within politicized cultural movements, Falls and Smith demonstrate how these erstwhile domestic, utilitarian objects explode the art/craft dichotomy, belong to a rich narrative of historical art forms, and tell us far more about American culture today than simply representing a nostalgic past, particularly with regard to ideas about race, class, nationalism, women's labor, and the separation of private versus public spaces.
