A Political Practice of Occupational Therapy is about maximizing the potential impact of occupational therapists' engagements and ensuring the profession is working towards the construction of a civic society. O caráter interdisciplinar da formação departamental impulsionou a análise da deficiência, em suas múltiplas dimensões - bio-psico-social - mas, ao mesmo tempo, o vínculo com a educação exigiu que essas reflexões se apresentassem fincadas fortemente no compromisso com os processos educativos, em diferentes âmbitos: na escola, nas instituições, nos serviços de apoio, na comunidade, na profissionalização, em hospitais e, inclusive, na família. Fruto do acúmulo de muitas reflexões, realizadas em diferentes instâncias, de caráter interdisciplinar, reunindo pesquisadores da área da Pedagogia, da Psicologia, da Fisioterapia, da Terapia Ocupacional, da Fonoaudiologia, da Genética e do Serviço Social, traz diferentes luzes na interpretação da condição da deficiência e da inclusão escolar. Os capítulos reafirmam a opção pela inclusão escolar, mas o fazem sem negar a educação especial e suas contribuições inquestionáveis, para que possamos combater a exclusão oculta que vem ocorrendo internamente na escola, quando são desconsideradas as necessidades específicas daqueles estudantes com deficiência.

Este libro muestra una comprensión sobre la formación de los terapeutas ocupacionales, visibilizando la educación como un proceso histórico que ha mostrado caminos importantes para la consolidación de una profesión necesaria y esencial en la dignificación de la vida y el fomento del bienestar; que a la vez, propone rutas en su problematización constante.

The use of COSMOS for the analysis and solution of structural dynamics problems is introduced in this new edition. The COSMOS

program was selected from among the various professional programs available because it has the capability of solving complex problems in structures, as well as in other engineering fields such as Heat Transfer, Fluid Flow, and Electromagnetic Phenomena. COSMOS includes routines for Structural Analysis, Static, or Dynamics with linear or nonlinear behavior (material nonlinearity or large displacements), and can be used most efficiently in the microcomputer. The larger version of COSMOS has the capacity for the analysis of structures modeled up to 64,000 nodes. This fourth edition uses an introductory version that has a capability limited to 50 nodes or 50 elements. This version is included in the supplement, STRUCTURAL DYNAMICS USING COSMOS 1. The sets of educational programs in Structural Dynamics and Earthquake Engineering that accompanied the third edition have now been extended and updated. These sets include programs to determine the response in the time or frequency domain using the FFT (Fast Fourier Transform) of structures modeled as a single oscillator. Also included is a program to determine the response of an inelastic system with elastoplastic behavior and a program for the development of seismic response spectral charts. A set of seven computer programs is included for modeling structures as two-dimensional and three dimensional frames and trusses.
